#### Information sessions

#### Head Lice

If you didn't give your permission for your child to be checked, I ask you to please ensure that you do a thorough check yourself this weekend and treat your child if needed.

Hopefully, we will begin on Monday with this problem eradicated. However, for this to happen, we must all work together. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

#### Complaints Regarding the Playground

I am still receiving complaints regarding the behaviour the students after-school on the playground. These complaints include a lack of active supervision by some parents, a lack of respect for school toys and equipment, leaving the playground untidy and strewn with litter. Unfortunately, my requests for cooperation do not seem to be adequately addressing this problem.

Please be aware that this is my final request. If I receive any more complaints, I will withdraw the privilege of using this space after-school and the playground will only be used during school time when it is supervised by the school staff.
